

**GREENE COUNTY QUORUM COURT
GREENE COUNTY COURTHOUSE
APRIL 15, 2024
MINUTES**

The Greene County Quorum Court held its regular meeting Monday, April 15, 2024, in the Circuit Courtroom on the second floor of the Greene County Courthouse with County Judge Rusty McMillon presiding. The following were in attendance: Justices Sherma Dicus, Robby Glasco, Bill McCartney, Jonathon Davis, Michele Boling, Phillip Keeling, Allen Davis, Dean Wooldridge, Ronnie Roberts, and Clint Harris. Justice Marc Reeves was absent.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance led by County Judge Rusty McMillon and followed by a prayer from Justice Dean Wooldridge.

Justice Robby Glasco made a motion and Justice Dean Wooldridge seconded to amend the April 15, 2024, agenda, adding a report of Residential Housing Facilities Board. The motion carried.

Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Phillip Keeling seconded to amend the March 18, 2024, minutes by correcting the title of the "Greene County Human Services Facilities Board", which was on the minutes as "Greene County Human Services Board". The motion carried.

Justice Ronnie Roberts made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to accept the minutes of the March 18, 2024, meeting. The minutes were accepted.
