

**GREENE COUNTY QUORUM COURT

SEPTMEBER 15, 2025
MINUTES**

The Greene County Quorum Court held its regular meeting Monday, September 15, 2025, in the Circuit Courtroom on the second floor of the Greene County Courthouse with Justice Jonathon Davis presiding. The following were in attendance: Justices Sherma Dicus, Robby Glasco, Bill McCartney, Jonathon Davis, Michele Boling, Allen Davis, Dean Wooldridge, Marc Reeves, Ronnie Roberts, and Kirk Brinkley. Justice Phillip Keeling became present later in the meeting.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Justice Jonathon Davis and followed by a prayer from Justice Marc Reeves.

Justice Ronnie Roberts made a motion to vote for Justice Jonathon Davis to preside over meeting in County Judge Rusty McMillon's absence. The vote was affirmed, all in favor.

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Michele Bolins seconded to accept the minutes of the August 18, 2025, meeting. The minutes were accepted.

PUBLIC COMMENTS (FOR ITEMS ON THE AGENDA) – None.

PERSONNEL TEAM – Chairman Marc Reeves stated that the Personnel Team has accepted the policy that would be presented during this meeting.

Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Phillip Keeling seconded to table an Ordinance titled **“AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE TERM LIMITS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 1978-22 AND 2003-07, FOR THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSING FACILITIES BOARD OF GREENE COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO”** for next month's meeting. The motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS –

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to table an Ordinance titled **“AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE TERM LIMITS AND BOARD SUCCESSION AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2025-11, 1992-8, AND 2013-10, FOR THE GREENE COUNTY HUMAN SERVICES FACILITIES BOARD, AND FOR OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO.”** for next months meeting. The motion carried.

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Dean Wooldridge seconded to put an Ordinance titled **“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2018-01, 2022-09 REGARDING THE EMPLOYMENT POLICY FOR GREENE COUNTY, ARKANSAS”**, on its first reading. The Ordinance was read in its entirety by Attorney Wesley Watts. Justice Sherma Dicus made a motion and Justice Michele Boling seconded to accept the Ordinance as read. The motion carried. Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Kirk Brinkley seconded to suspend the

rules and put it on its 2nd reading by title only. The motion carried, and the Ordinance was read, title only, by Attorney Wesley Watts. Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Michele Boling seconded to accept the 2nd reading, title only. The motion carried. Justice Phillip Keeling made a motion and Justice Marc Reeves seconded to suspend the rules and put it on its 3rd and final reading, by title only. The motion carried, and the Ordinance was read, title only, by Attorney Wesley Watts. Justice Kirk Brinkley made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to accept the 3rd and final reading. Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Allen Davis seconded to add the Emergency Clause. All in favor, none opposed, and the motion carried. The Ordinance was adopted as read.

Justice Bill McCartney made a motion and Justice Phillip Keeling seconded to suspend the rules and put an Ordinance titled "**AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND GREENE COUNTY ORDINANCES 2024-27**" on its first reading by title only. The Ordinance was read, title only, by Attorney Wesley Watts. Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Ronnie Roberts seconded to accept the Ordinance as Read. The motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS (FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA) – None.

Justice Kirk Brinkley made a motion and Justice Michele Boling seconded to adjourn. The motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
