

**GREENE COUNTY QUORUM COURT
GREENE COUNTY COURTHOUSE
AUGUST 18, 2025
MINUTES**

The Greene County Quorum Court held its regular meeting Monday, August 18, 2025, in the District Courtroom on the second floor of the Greene County Courthouse with County Judge Rusty McMillon presiding. The following were in attendance: Justices Sherma Dicus, Robby Glasco, Bill McCartney, Jonathon Davis, Michele Boling, Phillip Keeling, Dean Wooldridge, Marc Reeves, Ronnie Roberts, and Kirk Brinkley. Justice Allen Davis was absent.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance led by County Judge Rusty McMillon and followed by a prayer from Justice Kirk Brinkley.

Justice Phillip Keeling made a motion and Justice Marc Reeves seconded to accept the minutes of the July 21, 2025, meeting. The minutes were accepted.

PUBLIC COMMENTS (FOR ITEMS ON THE AGENDA) – None.

PERSONNEL TEAM – Chairman Marc Reeves stated that the Personnel Team met to discuss updates to the Greene County Personnel Policy.

FINANCE TEAM – Did not meet. Chairman Jonathon Davis stated that the budget process has begun for 2026 budget and that Finance Team meetings would be beginning very soon.

PUBLIC WORKS TEAM – Met directly before Quorum Court. Lance Blythe spoke to the Public Works team about adding a position that the Extension Office has not had for a while. This position would be a Family Consumer Science agent. This agent would be responsible for childcare training, serve safe food certification, physical and mental health impacts, and help with money management, which are all research-based programs.

OLD BUSINESS–

Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Phillip Keeling seconded to put an Ordinance titled “**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE TERM LIMITS AND AMENDING ORDINANCE 1978-22 AND 2003-07, FOR THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSING FACILITIES BOARD OF GREENE COUNTY, ARKANSAS, AND FOR OTHER MATTERS PERTAINING THERETO**” on its first reading. The Ordinance was read by Attorney Kimberly Dale. Attorney Kimberly Dale spoke with Judge McMillon that the Ordinance presented was not the most recent draft. County Judge Rusty McMillon stated that the Ordinance would remain on Old Business for the September monthly meeting and the most recent version would be presented at that time.

County Judge Rusty McMillon stated that Sheriff Brad Snyder stated no need for funds requested and to strike the Appropriation Ordinance titled “**AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND GREENE COUNTY ORDINANCE 2024-27**” from the agenda.

NEW BUSINESS –

Justice Kirk Brinkley made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to approve County funds be used to send a County employee to Leadership Paragould program through the Paragould Chamber of Commerce. Vote of affirmation with none opposed or abstained. The motion was approved.

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Dean Wooldridge seconded to approve moving forward with creating government email addresses for all Justices of the Peace, through NEASEM. Vote of affirmation with none opposed or abstained. The motion was approved.

Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Marc Reeves seconded to read a Resolution titled “**A RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE THE ARKANSAS 250 COMMISSION AS IT BEGINS ITS WORK TO CELEBRATE ARKANSAS’S TWO-HUNDRED-FIFTY-YEAR HISTORY FROM THE SIGNING OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE ON JULY 4, 1776, THROUGH JULY 4, 2026**” The motion carried. The Resolution was read by Attorney Kimberly Dale. Justice Ronnie Roberts made a motion and Justice Kirk Brinkley seconded to approve. All in favor, none opposed. The motion carried. The Resolution was adopted as read.

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to suspend the rules and put an Ordinance titled "**AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND GREENE COUNTY ORDINANCES 2024-27 & 2025-13**" on its first reading by title only. The Ordinance was read, title only, by Attorney Kimberly Dale. Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Bill McCartney seconded to accept the Ordinance as Read. The motion carried.

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Robby Glasco seconded to suspend the rules and put an Ordinance titled "**AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND GREENE COUNTY ORDINANCES 2024-27**" on its first reading by title only. The Ordinance was read, title only, by Attorney Kimberly Dale. Justice Sherma Dicus made a motion and Justice Jonathon Davis seconded to accept the Ordinance as Read. The motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS (FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA) – Bufford Newberry spoke to the Court regarding bridge repairs on County Road 210 and 211.

Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to adjourn. The motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
