The Greene County Quorum Court held its regular meeting Monday, July 20, 2026, in the Circuit Courtroom on the second floor of the Greene County Courthouse with County Judge Rusty McMillon presiding. The following were in attendance: Justices Sherma Dicus, Robby Glasco, Bill McCartney, Michele Boling, Allen Davis, Dean Wooldridge, Marc Reeves, Ronnie Roberts, and Kirk Brinkley. Justice Phillip Keeling was absent.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance led by County Judge Rusty McMillon and followed by a prayer from Justice Marc Reeves.

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Allen Davis seconded to accept the minutes of the June 15, 2026, meeting. The minutes were accepted.

Justice Robby Glasco made a motion and Justice Allen Davis seconded to read a Resolution titled **"A RESOLUTION DECLARING A VACANCY IN THE POSITION OF JUSTICE OF THE PEACE DISTRICT #4 IN GREENE COUNTY, ARKANSAS"**. The motion carried. The Resolution was read by Attorney Kimberly Dale. Justice Dean Wooldridge made a motion and Justice Bill McCartney seconded to approved. All in favor, none opposed. The motion carried. The resolution was adopted as read.

Justice Robby Glasco made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to suspend the rules and put an Ordinance titled **"AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND GREENE COUNTY ORDINANCE 2025-24"** on its first reading by title only. The Ordinance was read, title only, by Attorney Kimberly Dale. Justice Robby Glasco made a motion and Justice Marc Reeves seconded to accept the Ordinance as Read. The motion carried.
