The Greene County Quorum Court held its regular meeting Monday, May 18, 2026, in the Circuit Courtroom on the second floor of the Greene County Courthouse with County Judge Rusty McMillon presiding. The following were in attendance: Justices Sherma Dicus, Robby Glasco, Bill McCartney, Jonathon Davis, Michele Boling, Phillip Keeling, Allen Davis, Dean Wooldridge, Marc Reeves, Ronnie Roberts, and Kirk Brinkley.

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance led by County Judge Rusty McMillon and followed by a prayer from Justice Phillip Keeling.

Justice Marc Reeves made a motion and Justice Allen Davis seconded to accept the minutes of the April 20, 2026, meeting. The minutes were accepted.

OLD BUSINESS–

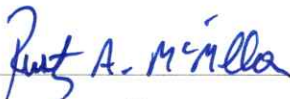

The motion carried and the resolution was approved, all in favor, none opposed.

Justice Robby Glasco made a motion and Justice Sherma Dicus seconded to suspend the rules and put an Ordinance titled "**AN APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE TO AMEND GREENE COUNTY ORDINANCE 2025-24.**" on its first reading by title only. The Ordinance was read, title only, by Attorney Wes Watts. Justice Phillip Keeling made a motion and Justice Kirk Brinkley seconded to accept the Ordinance as Read. The motion carried.
